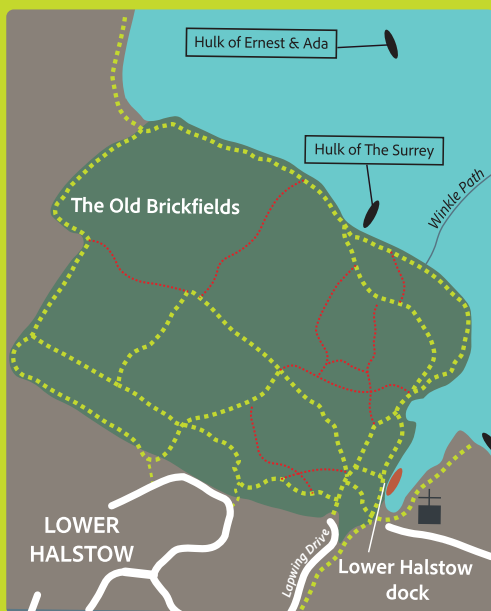


How to listen to Hulked
